## Indexes and abstracts

**Academic Search Premier**

Provides full text for more than 3,430 scholarly publications covering academic areas of study including social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, and ethnic studies. This database is updated on a daily basis.

**INDEX REF Z 7163.A66H1**

ASSIA (Applied Social Sciences Index and Abstracts) 1987-1992

An index of journal citations and abstracts of articles in the applied social sciences. It offers direct access to over 500 English-language journals in one alphabetical sequence - abstracts are not numbered. Subject and author index.

**Hayworth Press**

E-journal subscriptions in social work and pharmacy, including the following journals: *Child & Family Behavior Therapy*, *Journal of Gerontological Social Work*, *Journal of Pharmaceutical Marketing & Management*, *Journal of Teaching in Social Work*, *Social Work in Health Care*, and *Social Work With Groups*.

**JSTOR**

A collection of full text scholarly journals in the following subject areas: African American Studies, Anthropology, Asian Studies, Ecology, Economics, Education, Finance, History, Literature, Mathematics, Philosophy, Political Science, Population Studies, Sociology, and Statistics.

**GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS (LIBRARY ANNEX)**Monthly Catalog of U.S. Government Publications

Indexes publications of the various branches, departments, and agencies of the U.S.. government. Useful for social-work-related topics.

**netLibrary**

Provides easy access to the full text of more than 10,000 reference, scholarly, and professional books.

**Project MUSE**

Project MUSE provides online, worldwide, institutional subscription access to the full text of over 100 scholarly journals in the arts and humanities, social sciences and mathematics.

**PsycARTICLES**

Ovid provides access to journals through the Journals@Ovid database in the subject area of psychology and psychiatry.

**PsycINFO**

Indexes over 1300 journals in psychology and related disciplines from 1887 to present. Journals@Ovid provides full text to over 30 journals.

Indexes articles in over 150 scholarly periodicals in the social sciences.
